

John M. Stamatos, MD, is the director of pain management at Syosset and Plainview Hospitals. He also serves as a pain management specialist at North Shore University Hospital in Manhasset.

Dr. Stamatos attended Hamilton College in Clinton, New York where he graduated *magna cum laude*. He completed his medical training at the Uniformed Services University of Health Sciences and his residency in anesthesiology at the Walter Reed Army Medical Center. He also is a member of several medical societies including the American Neuromodulation Society, American Society of Pain, American Society of Regional Anesthesia, International Anesthesia Research Society and International Association for the Study of Pain.
