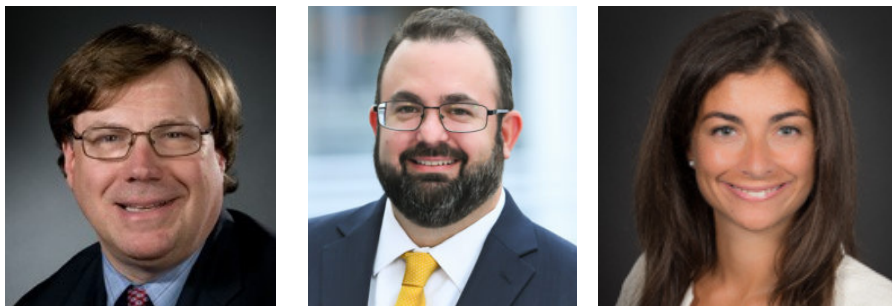

The diagnostic decision-making process is complex, involving multiple systems, processes, members of the health care team and patients to ensure diagnoses are made in a timely and accurate manner.
