In early 2010, Mr. Gabriele was appointed a Special Prosecutor for the Nassau County District Attorney's Office on a case involving technological patents and extortion. Mr. Gabriele lectures to students about Internet safety and cyber-bullying. Most recently, Mr. Gabriele presented to attorneys at the Suffolk County Bar Association on the topics of Cyber-Bullying and the investigation of computer-related legal matters.
